### FICTIONAL CHARACTERS – ART

#### Activity Name:

You Know My Name

#### Curriculum Focus:

English/ Art

#### Age Phase:

7-11 (KS2)

#### Activity:

The Beatles are famous for writing songs based on particular characters. The characters are sometimes fictional, for example, 'Billy Shears' from Sgt Peppers but some are also based on factual information, for example, Lucy in the Sky with Diamonds was written by John Lennon when his son Julian brought home a picture from school of his friend Lucy and named the picture 'Lucy in the Sky with Diamonds'

#### Task:

Choose a fictional character from any Beatles song and draw what you think they might look like. See some examples below:

- 'The Fool' from The Fool on the Hill
- 'The Girl with Kaleidoscope Eyes' from Lucy in the Sky with Diamonds
- 'Mr Mustard' from Mean Mr Mustard
- 'Rocky Raccoon' from The White Album
- 'Billy Shears' from Sgt Pepper Lonely Hearts Club Band and Little Help from My Friends
